AG&P was contracted by DSME to undertake the offshore hook-up, pre-commissioning and commissioning assistance for the Sanha Condensate Platform Complex in Angola. Sanha Condensate Complex serves as a natural gas processing hub for surrounding production facilities with combined yearly production averaging 100,000 barrels a day of oil, condensate and LPG.

AG&P deployed 276 workers to the site including pipe fitters, structural fitters, mechanics, electricians, instrument technicians, painters, riggers and non-destructive evaluators (NDE) who undertook the structural, mechanical and piping works, E&I, scaffolding, blasting, painting and insulation. The workers arrived onsite ready to work and fully trained to comply with international safety and quality standards.

AG&P is licensed by the Philippine government to recruit, process and deploy locally based workers to overseas jobs. AG&P is a consistent recipient of awards and recognition by the government and clients for excellence in overseas manpower deployment.
